Should the Government directives be ignored, then stricter the controls such a full lock down, will/may need to be enforced in the future and the greater the negative economic impact will be for everyone. Therefore, as responsible owners of Thorn Tree Bush Camp we would like to urge all our guests to please be responsible, selfless, rational and supportive.

Thorn Tree Bush Camp will remain open and continue to operate until any new directives are handed down by either the Government or Dinokeng Game Reserve requiring otherwise.

Our bush camps are self-catering tented bush camps. We are a small family business, well situated within the Dinokeng Game Reserve and natural bushveld. Making the likelihood of becoming infected less likely. Our Bush camps offer a great opportunity for guests to unwind and destress away from the current hassles and challenges of the modern world.

We would like to assure guests of the following safety measures are implemented in order to protect as far as possible:

- Improved more frequent sanitizing of high-risk areas and/or the bush camp.
- Our staff live on site – so lower risk of becoming infected in taxis etc.

We would like to advise guests the following, with regards to paid bookings for the period 10 March to 15<sup>th</sup> April 2020:
